

MEGA EYE CAMP CONCLUDES

The 3-days Cataract Surgery Operation camp concluded here today that is 26th of February 2010 at District Hospital Bomdila with an appreciable number of patients being operated upon. Organized by the District Blindness Control Society Bomdila under National Rural Health Mission Programme, a total of 264 cases were registered out of which 23 cataract operable cases including one minor operation on Syringing was operated by the senior most Eye Surgeon and State Project Officer Dr. K. K. Deb assisted by Ophthalmologist Dr. D. Grayu.

Earlier in the inaugural function on 24th last in the Conference Hall of the District Hospital Bomdila, the chairman of DBCS Bomdila and the Chief Guest of the day Deputy Commissioner Swati Sharma underscoring the importance of eye sight suggested for wide publicity with regards to the extensive examinations of the school going children's eyes in the district. The State Project Officer cum Chief Surgeon Dr. Deb deliberated on the various cases of blindness with special emphasis on cataract and urged for popularization of eye donation in the area. Earlier, the District Medical Officer Dani Duri while dealing on the aims and objectives of the camp informed that so far a total of 07 eye camps have been conducted in the district with maximum coverage and success.
