

Coordination Meeting For Cleanliness Drive

The District Administration of West Kameng District gets an encouraging boost in its endeavor to maintain the serenity of beautiful Hill Station Bomdila when the people from all walks of life pledging to extend their services in maintaining the cleanliness and greenery of the small hill town. A coordination meeting between District Administration, HODs and public was convened by Deputy Commissioner Shri Rinchin Tashi at Multi-Sports Complex. In the meeting entire township was divided into small sectors and duties were delegated to its leaders and deputy leaders for maintaining the cleanliness and greenery.

Speaking on the occasion Shri Tashi assured to address the important points raised by the present members regarding clean water supply, making safety tanks mandatory for all the buildings, awareness on cleanliness and civic sense, construction of public toilets within the township, menace of increasing population of stray dogs, earmarking of common waste disposal point, etc.

Shri Tashi agreed to constitute a monitoring team comprising of Town Magistrate and Police to check sector wise implementation of the cleanliness drive. He further advocated for formulation of committees for monitoring of water sources and identifying a permanent location for cremation of the dead bodies.

Answering to a question raised by a member regarding dilapidated road condition between Tipi and Elephant flat in West Kameng district which has already claimed a life and caused massive public inconvenience the Deputy commissioner appraised the house that the matter has been put forward to Chief Engineer, project Vartak and Commander 14 BRTF for carrying out the widening work of roads on pocket wise basis rather than disturbing the road on a large stretch.

The coordinator of the meeting Shri V.P.Singh, Dy Director, DUDA while expressing his gratitude promised to extend full support of his department in making the drive a successful one.
