

CO-ORDINATION MEETING

Addressing the first coordination meeting of all the HODs of the district headquarter after assuming the charges of the Deputy Commissioner of the district, Rinchin Tashi made an appeal to reach out to the people as the departments and the officers are responsible for the effective implementation of the various programmes and policies of the government. All-out efforts should be made to ensure that the benefits of the developmental activities reach the people at the grass-root level by their personal interest and intervention and also by keeping a tab on the presence and availability of their staffs in their respective places of posting. Until and unless the government servants are responsive and accountable, the developmental activities cant take place in true sense, he said.

Uholding the adage of Clean and Green Arunachal, DC Tashi emphasized on the effective disposal system by digging garbage pits in one's residential premises and conducting mass sanitation drives on last Friday of every month in the district headquarters Bomdila and in its peripheral areas starting from 30th of this month. Likewise, taking advantage of the early monsoon, plantation of saplings would be carried out in the premises of every household on 7th of May ; the upkeepment of which would rest with the concerned family members.

Dwelling on matters of immediate concern like that of illegal encroachment of government land and mushrooming up of illegal construction in the district headquarters, the DC assured of initiating prompt disciplinary actions. On the question of rampant and unauthorized quarrying being carried out in an around Bomdila township which leads to landslide of varying magnitudes triggered by the incessant rainfalls and poor drainage system, the DC directed the AMDO to put a check on it particularly on the quarrying being done at sera, pedung and under Bomdila Township. Worried by the early onset of monsoon and the incessant rainfalls in the area and beyond, DC Tashi called upon the officers to be prepared in advance for any eventuality. The district has witnessed several natural calamities in the past leading to loss of valuable human lives and properties worth in crores. Therefore, the key departments like the police, Medical, Civil Supplies, PWD, Power, PHED, very etc along with the Disaster Management Unit because it always pays to be well prepared, he quipped.
