

## **A STEP TOWARDS HARMONIOUS LIVING WITH NATURE AND WILD LIFE**

Although West Kameng District is supposed to be a protective habitat for wild life, there has been massive hunting activities in the entire district from recent past mostly out of fascination of killing animals and birds by educated people from affluent societies to merely fulfill their hobbies endangering lives of precious species of wild life leading to ecological imbalance.

In order to put halt on rampant huntings so as to ensure peaceful coexistence and harmonious living with nature and wild life, Deputy Commissioner cum District Magistrate Rinchin Tashi issued order directing all law abiding citizens of the district to refrain from such illegal huntings and warned that any person found guilty on conviction shall be punished with sentence of imprisonment or with fine or with both as per relevant section of the wild life protection Act 1972 extended to Arunachal Pradesh.
