

WOMEN'S DAY

To commemorate the 100th International Women's Day, a Medical Health Camp was organized at Subu, a remote village bereft of medical facilities under Thrizino circle located at a distance of 104 kilometres from Bomdila, the district headquarters of West Kameng by the District Administration in association with the Medical Unit of 5-Mtn Division Tenga, the district Health department, department of ICDS and PHE & W/S with an NGO-Women Welfare Center Bomdila for the people of the 17 villages under Thrizino circle and for awareness creation on Total Sanitation Campaign.

Inaugurating the Health Camp, DC Swati Sharma accompanied by the army personnels and all the Head of Departments, underscored the importance of a good health and reiterated that it is high time to make a concerted effort and work as a team for the all round development of the society with special emphasis on health sector.
